

If you arrive to The Netherlands by plane to the airport of **Schiphol**, the best way to reach us is by train. The train station at Schiphol is below the main hall of the airport. At the main hall you can buy your ticket at the blue and yellow counter or machines. Should you stay for a longer period or plan to return, you can also buy a transport card that you can use for all other transports in every city of the country. From The Hague Central to Royal Conservatoire (Juliana van Stolberglaan 1)

When you arrive at The Hague Central, you can either walk, take a tram or a taxi to the Royal Conservatoire. You can find the map from the Hague Central to the Royal Conservatoire on the last page of this document. When you decide to go by tram, here you find a few options:

- Tram 2 in direction Leidschendam from stop The Hague Central—get off at stop Ternoot (in front of the Royal Conservatoire) (1 stop). From this stop it is about a 2 minutes' walk to the Royal Conservatoire.
- Tram 6 in direction Leidschendam Noord from stop The Hague Central get off at stop Ternoot (in front of the Royal Conservatoire) (1 stop). From this stop it is about a 2 minutes' walk to the Royal Conservatoire.

From The Hague Central to Easy Hotel Den Haag (Parkstraat 31, Centrum, 2514 JD The Hague)
When you arrive at The Hague Central, you can either take a tram, bus or a taxi to Easy Hotel. When you decide to go by tram, here you find a few options:

- Tram 16 in direction Den Haag Statenkwatier from stop The Hague Central—get off at stop Buitenhof (2 stops). From this stop it is about a 5 minutes' walk to the Hotel.
- Tram 15 in direction Nootdorp from stop The Hague Central get off at stop Buitenhof (2 stops). From this stop it is about a 5 minutes' walk to the Hotel.


or

- Bus 24 in direction Den Haag Kijkduin from stop The Hague Central—get off at stop Kneuterdijk (3 stops). From this stop it is about a 2 minutes' walk to the Hotel.
- Bus 22 in direction Den Haag Duindorp from stop The Hague Central—get off at stop Kneuterdijk (3 stops). From this stop it is about a 2 minutes' walk to the Hotel.

From Easy Hotel to Studio Aus LICHT (Kranenburgweg 203, 2583 ER The Hague)


Bus 28 (every 15 minutes) in direction Den Haag Zuiderstrand from stop Kneuterdijk – get off at stop Norfolk (10 stops). From this stop it is about a 4 minutes' walk to the studio.
